MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Administration of Unit Risk Inventory to Redeployed Soldiers

1. In accordance with the Deployment Cycle Support CONPLAN (Paragraph Six) Soldiers redeploying from Operations Iraqi Freedom, Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation Noble Eagle are to be administered the Redeployment Unit Risk Inventory (RURI) at enclosure within 90 days of their return. Development of this product was delayed, but it is now ready for administration.
2. The purpose of the RURI is to provide unit commanders a quick assessment of their Soldier's behavior during deployment and after deployment. It is designed to be a tool for the commander in determining what Soldiers may need in terms of education, assistance or counseling and adjustment to the stresses they are under in these times of uncertainty and danger. Administration of the RURI can be completed in one hour.
3. Active component commanders may request administration of the RURI from their installation Alcohol and Drug Control Officer. USAR component commanders may request administration from their Reserve Readiness Command Alcohol and Drug Control Officer.
