

| <b>Alcohol and Other Drug Use</b>      |       |     |  |
| 20%                                    | 21%   | 21% | Have ridden with a driver who was DUI.   |
| 15%                                    | 16%   | 18% | Have driven under the influence of alcohol/drugs.                                      |
| > 17%                                  | 16%   | 16% | Say their leaders do not treat driving while intoxicated as a serious offense.         |
| 1%                                     | 6%    | 5%  | Have been detained or arrested in conjunction with alcohol/drug use.                   |
| > 10%                                  | 13%   | 9%  | Have committed an illegal act while drinking.  |

| <b>Unit Cohesion</b>                   |       |     |  |

| <b>Self-Perception / Relationships</b> |       |     |  |
| 22%                                    | 32%   | 49% | Often feel angry and frustrated.   |
| 19%                                    | 21%   | 21% | Often feel lonely.   |
| > 36%                                  | 36%   | 32% | Hardly ever or never have people to turn to for support in bad moments or illness.     |
| > 30%                                  | 28%   | 28% | Have had an important relationship end.  |
| > 46%                                  | 44%   | 50% | Have experienced two or more life changes or difficult circumstances.                  |
| > 63%                                  | 61%   | 60% | Are only somewhat satisfied or not satisfied with their life.                          |

| > 11%                          | 12%   | 10% | Have had suicidal thoughts.  |
| > 21%                          | 21%   | 15% | Of those having suicidal thoughts, made a plan.  |
| 2%                             | 3%    | 6%  | Have attempted suicide.  |
| <b>Other Crimes</b>            |       |     |  |
| 1%                             | 3%    | 4%  | Have stolen or shoplifted something.   |
| 2%                             | 4%    | 6%  | Have vandalized property.  |
| 0%                             | 4%    | 4%  | Have committed a crime against another person.   |
| <b>Sexual Practices</b>        |       |     |  |
| > 64%                          | 60%   | 39% | Do not practice safe sex.  |
| 3%                             | 3%    | 4%  | Have been diagnosed with a STD.  |
| > 24%                          | 22%   | 36% | Have had more than one sex partner.  |
| <b>Physical / Sexual Abuse</b> |       |     |  |
| > 25%                          | 24%   | 25% | Think they received physically abusive punishment from their parents/guardians (by today's standards). |
| 5%                             | 6%    | 10% | Think their parents/guardians physically abused them (by their own standards).                         |
| 6%                             | 7%    | 6%  | Have threatened their spouse or girlfriend/boyfriend.  |
| 6%                             | 8%    | 8%  | Have pushed, shoved, slapped, grabbed, or hit their spouse or a girlfriend/boyfriend.                  |
| 5%                             | 5%    | 11% | Have insulted or sworn at a child.   |
| > 31%                          | 27%   | 30% | Have spanked a child and left a mark.  |
| 5%                             | 6%    | 6%  | Have pushed, shoved, hit with their hand, or kicked a child.   |
| > 12%                          | 13%   | 8%  | Have hit a child with a belt or other object.  |
| <b>Army Environment</b>        |       |     |  |
| 54%                            | 55%   | 55% | Have spent 31 or more days away from home due to military requirements.                                |
| 57%                            | 58%   | 57% | Do not have enough time to relax due to job demands.   |
| > 38%                          | 32%   | 40% | Are only somewhat satisfied or not satisfied with Army life.   |
| > 23%                          | 23%   | 20% | Do not plan to reenlist/stay in the Army.  |
